Travel Funding Policy

JHFE may fund travel for the following purposes:

Continuing education/professional development

JHFE recognizes the importance of continuing education and will entertain requests to fund domestic travel related to staff development. Continuing education grants may include:

- Full registration/conference fees
- Up to 50% of domestic, coach class airfare
- Up to 50% of accommodation fees at the conference site/affiliated hotel

Educational field trips

JHFE will entertain requests from educational organizations for funding of youth educational travel. Such travel must be directly connected to Jewish culture and/or Jewish identity. Only one educational travel grant will be considered per organization per calendar year.

Jewish overnight camp

JHFE provides funding for Jewish overnight camp through JHFE Jewish Identity Summer Scholarships, which are administered by the Jewish Community of Louisville and based on need. Scholarship recipients will be asked to complete an evaluation as determined by JHFE.

Israel travel for youth

JHFE supports youth travel to Israel through JHFE Jewish Identity Summer Scholarships administered by the Jewish Community of Louisville. Scholarship recipients will be asked to complete a post-trip evaluation as determined by JHFE.

JHFE does not fund international travel for professionals and clergy.
